

# THIRD DIMENSION SOCIETY (UK) 48th STEREO EXHIBITION

In 2011 all photographers active in the field of stereo colour photography are invited to submit their best work to our International Stereo Exhibition. The Selectors will be looking for original and artistic interpretations of a wide variety of subject matter. Consideration will also be given to accuracy of stereo mounting, essential for comfortable viewing. The Exhibition is sponsored by the 3D Division of PSA, and all acceptances will be credited to the 3D Division.

The Exhibition will comprise three sections. A maximum of 12 images may be entered, apportioned as below:-

- (1) **SLIDES SECTION:** Entrants are invited to submit up to 4 stereoscopic slide images in any slide/transparency format.
- (2) **PRINTS SECTION:** Entrants are invited to submit up to 4 prints in any stereoscopic print format.
- (3) **DIGITAL SECTION:** Entrants are invited to submit up to 4 digital pairs as 8 JPG format frames, max dimensions 1400 x 1050 pixels per frame, max file sizes 1Mb per frame.

The images selected as the best in each of the three Sections will be awarded a PSA Gold Medal. In all sections, Second and Third Award plaques and Certificates of Merit will also be given. Acceptance Certificates will be given to all successful entries. Award Plaques may be given in each section for the following subject categories: Natural History; Landscape/Seascape; Photojournalism; Humour; Human Beings; Best Use of Stereo (the photograph most enhanced by the addition of the Third Dimension). Every entrant will receive a copy of the printed colour Exhibition Catalogue. The Exhibition will have around 8 showings in England, UK. ## EXHIBITION CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**SLIDE SECTION:** Up to 4 stereoscopic photographs in any combination of slide formats in any colour process may be submitted. An entrant's slides will be distributed throughout four rounds of judging. Only the slide titles will be announced during selection. All 4"x1<sup>5</sup>/<sub>8</sub>" (101x41 mm) slides and pairs of 2"x2" (50x50 mm) slides will be judged by projection using 250 watt Q.I. lamps. Other slide formats (such as Medium Format or ViewMaster) will be judged in hand viewers. Foil mounts with glass binding, or RBT plastic mounts, are recommended for 101x41mm slides. All other slide mounting methods (such as card mounts, EMDE etc.) are acceptable. No slides will be remounted or adjusted in any way.

**PRINT SECTION:** Up to 4 stereoscopic photographs in any combination of print formats in any colour process may be submitted. An entrant's four images will be distributed throughout four rounds of judging. Print entries in Holmes (side by side), ViewMagic (one above the other) & other large or multiple stereo-card formats are acceptable, as are anaglyph prints. Prints will be viewed using appropriate hand viewers. Prints should have title and author written on the reverse side.

**DIGITAL SECTION:** Up to 4 stereoscopic digital photographs may be submitted as 8 individual JPEG frames. The dimensions of each Left or Right frame must not exceed 1400x1050 pixels. Submit left and right frames as separate JPEG files, suitably named (e.g. SMITH-1-Mountain-L, SMITH-1-Mountain-R, SMITH-2-Children-L, SMITH-2-Children-R etc). The file size of each of the 8 frames is not to exceed 1Mbyte, (i.e. a maximum of 8Mbytes for the total digital entry). An entrant's four digital photographs will be distributed throughout four rounds of judging by digital projection on Optoma equipment. Digital entries supplied on CD will not be returned unless specifically requested.

The sponsors of this International Exhibition of Photography have been awarded Recognition by PSA, the world's largest patron of international photographic exhibitions. PSA, although it has provided Recognition, is neither a sponsor nor directly involved in the operation of this exhibition.

Acceptances received by PSA Members in approved sections of this exhibition are eligible for PSA Star Ratings, listing in the worldwide PSA Who's Who of Photography and credited toward the PSA Distinctions PPSA, EPSA, MPSA and GMPSA.

PSA is a non profit organization promoting the advancement of photography in all its forms to novice, amateur and professional photographers worldwide.

Every PSA Exhibition image must have a unique title. Images previously accepted in the Third Dimension Exhibition (or any derivatives therefrom) may not be re-entered in any TDS Exhibition section in any form, nor may that image be re-titled for any other PSA Exhibition. A photograph substantially the same as one previously accepted from the same maker may be disqualified. Unless otherwise requested by the author, images may be posted on the TDS website in low resolution.

The **ENTRY FEE** for one section (slides OR prints OR digital) is **£4.00 Sterling**, including return postage in the UK or **\$8 (US)** including return postage by Small Packet Airmail, or **6 Euros**.

The **ENTRY FEE** for any two sections (slides & prints, OR slides & digital, OR prints & digital) is **£6.00 Sterling**, including return postage in the UK or **\$12 (US)** including return postage by Small Packet Airmail, or **9 Euros**.

The **ENTRY FEE** for all three sections is **£7.00 Sterling**, including return postage in the UK or **\$14 (US)** including return postage by Small Packet Airmail, or **10 Euros**.

Payment may be made by **cheque in Pounds Sterling or US Dollars**, payable to "THIRD DIMENSION SOCIETY". Also **Banknotes/coins are accepted in Euros, Pounds Sterling or US dollars**.

The Exhibition will be conducted in accordance with the Standards of the Photographic Society of America 3D Division. The exhibition is open to anyone; however, an entry may be rejected when the sponsoring organization or its agent, in its reasonable discretion, believes the entry does not conform to the exhibition rules and conditions. Entries must be the work of the entrant, except for mounting. They can be home or trade processed. Entries must bear the title and the entrant's name, (all text to be on the reverse side of prints, all digital files to be named as noted earlier on page 1).

Entries must originate as photographs (image-captures of objects by light sensitivity) made by the entrant on photographic emulsion or acquired digitally. All images must be original and may not incorporate elements produced by anyone else. By virtue of submitting an entry, the entrant certifies the work as his own and permits the sponsors to reproduce all or part of the entered material free of charge for publication and/or display in media related to the exhibition. This may include low resolution posting on a website. The exhibition assumes no liability for any misuse of copyright. For digital section(s) images may be acquired digitally, or scanned from film by the entrant or a third party to create a digital file. Adjustments and cleaning may be performed to make the digital file match the original film image. Images may be altered, either electronically or otherwise, by the maker and artwork or computer graphics created by the entrant may be incorporated if the photographic content predominates, subject to divisional restrictions. All final work must be on photographic film or photographic or electronic print material, mounting excepted, or in digital JPG files (sizes noted earlier on page 1).

Every care will be taken with the entries but no responsibility can be accepted by the Society for loss or damage from any cause. Packing must be adequate since it will be used for return of slides and prints as far as is practicable. Lightweight packing such as expanded polystyrene or bubble plastic is recommended.
